The Indigenous Learning Circle (formerly Community Learning Centre for Promising Practices) began in 2006 in response to a recognized need for a “centre” that could capture the knowledge and promising practices within the community and share that knowledge with the broader community and future generations. In 2015, the ILC Steering Committee identified the development of an Indigenous Evaluation Bundle as one of its priorities.
