### **Social Impact Bonds in Manitoba: “Are we ready and how will we gauge success?”**

Social Impact Bonds (SIB) have been implemented in the U.K, U.S, and Canada. Recently, Manitoba made available its first ever social impact bond in child welfare. However, many questions still remain about the capacity within Manitoba-based not-for-profits and private sector stakeholders to take advantage of SIBs. Furthermore, how will the success of a SIB program be evaluated objectively? To answer these questions, this panel brings together key members from the public, private, not-for-profit in Manitoba sectors as well as a credentialed evaluator. Specifically, the panel will include:

- 1) Sandra Hodzic with the Wawanesa Insurance, formerly with the Government of Manitoba, that will provide specifics about SIBs in MB e.g. supports available for interested stakeholders;
- 2) Andrew Buchel, credentialed evaluator, will provide a professional perspective on the complexities of evaluating SIBs;
- 3) Dr. Jesse Hajer with the University of Manitoba and the Canadian Centre of Policy Alternatives that will discuss the capacity of their organization to participate in the provincial SIBs program.
- 4) Tara Petti from the Southern First Nation Network of Care to speak to the rationale for taking advantage of SIBs program in Manitoba.
